

RESOLUTION NO. 6086

Resolution of the City Council of the City of Sebastopol
Authorizing Continued Electric Vehicle Charging Station Services and Setting of Charges for
Use of the City Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol encourages the adoption and use of electric vehicles and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles through the installation of electric vehicle charging infrastructure as consistent with the City's goals to reduce greenhouse gas emissions resulting from transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol's participation in grant programs has resulted in the addition of electric vehicle charging stations to the City's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the period of the grant programs has ended and the City has the option to continue the operation of the electric vehicle charging stations and to establish charges to recover costs associated with delivery of service such as maintenance, operation, administration and electricity consumed by electric vehicle use of the stations and network expansion; and

WHEREAS, Staff has estimated that charges for the use of the electric vehicle charging stations would off-set expenses incurred by the City by providing the service and has confirmed that other agencies charge for the service; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing has been held pursuant to Government Code Sections 66018 and 6062; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sebastopol hereby:

1. Approves the continued delivery of the electric vehicle charging station service.
2. Establishes a \$2.00 connection charge, and a usage charge of \$1.00 per hour.
3. Directs that the monies collected will be separately accounted for and used to pay for costs associated with the system administration, maintenance, and electric vehicle charging program network expansion at City owned and leased facilities.
