

SEWER USE PERMIT REQUIRED

The City of Sebastopol Municipal Code Title 13.08.170 (A) states “All Nonresidential or Industrial user applicants who intend to connect their premises to the sewer on or after the effective date of this ordinance must obtain a Sewer Use Permit.”

The City of Santa Rosa is designated by City of Sebastopol to carry out permitting, inspections and monitoring procedures as necessary to determine compliance with applicable pretreatment standards issued under the City of Sebastopol Sewer Use Ordinance.

The requirement to obtain a permit applies to all new uses, and to change of ownership for existing permitted uses.

Prior to approval of a City of Sebastopol Business License, or prior occupancy of any new building or new connection to the City of Sebastopol sanitary sewer collection system, the applicant must provide evidence of approval or waiver of a Sewer Use Permit from the City of Santa Rosa Utilities Department Environmental Compliance Section.
