

The Sonoma County Regional Parks Department is proceeding with the Petaluma-Sebastopol trail feasibility study. The objective of this study is to identify feasibility of trail routes that would link Sebastopol and Petaluma, which would be a major community benefit. Sebastopol is contributing funding to the study.

The study process will include public workshops and other opportunities for public input. Both the Sebastopol Engineering Manager and the Planning Director will monitor the study process. The City also has the opportunity to designate a Council or citizen representative to the process.

Mayor Gurney has indicated interest in being the Council liaison to the study project. In addition, Geoffrey Skinner is currently Sebastopol's citizen representative to the Countywide Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (CBPAC), and is also willing to participate in the feasibility study process. In addition to his service with the CBPAC, Mr. Skinner has served on the City's Complete Streets Committee, and is an Alternate member of the Planning Commission.
