This is an external position opportunity. The City of Sebastopol Police Department is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Police Sergeant. **Regional Government Services and its staff is conducting this recruitment for the City of Sebastopol.**

Under the direction of the Chief of Police, and/or Police Lieutenant the Sergeant serves as the watch commander during their assigned shift. The Sergeant position is a mid-management position and is responsible for planning, organizing, and supervising the work of personnel in field operations.

Typical duties may include the following: patrol, inspect officers and equipment; give instructions; maintain discipline; assist officers in follow-up investigations; participate in investigations; oversee police operations and direct officers that are dispatched to crime scenes, traffic collisions, and emergency situations, and assist on these calls when required; participate in all normal patrol activities; assist officers in preparing reports for trial; appear in court, confer with prosecutors, and maintain contact with other law enforcement agencies; give information and direction to the public; review reports submitted by officers; conduct in-service training; write reports of performance for officers under their supervision; prepare reports of shift activity; and manage projects assigned by higher command.

- Demonstrates the ability to perform above the usual standards characterized by intelligence, integrity, maturity of mind, attention to others, and service to the public without discrimination.
- Has the ability to work effectively with a team of employees, building trust, inspiring, and motivating others by example, promoting teamwork, and bringing a group together with a shared sense of purpose.

- Can think clearly and act decisively in emergency situations while remaining calm under stressful conditions.
