



and sponsored a \$25,000 grant disbursement from County tourism enhancement funds to help with the Bodega improvements. The County Board of Supervisors recently approved this initiative!

The City intends to use this \$25,000 County grant to pay for part of the approximately \$250,000 cost for the HAWK crosswalk warning system at the Bodega Ave/Nelson Way intersection.

This County participation with Sebastopol transportation infrastructure projects of a regional benefit is to be just a first step in this regard. Subsequent to the initial conversations about the grant, Council Member Gurney and Supervisor Hopkins have also collaborated on joint planning for enhancements to Ragle Road, which straddles the western City/County boundary. In this instance the City and County are jointly preparing and submitting a statewide grant application for ATP (Active Transportation Program) funds for the Ragle Road improvements.

RECOMMENDATION:
