

 Subject: Discussion and Action of Proposed Resolution Approving a Revised SB1 Proposed Projects List for FY 19-20 and Submitting the List to the California Transportation Commission  
 Recommendation: Approval of City Council Resolution Approving the Revised SB1 Proposed Project List.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, also known as SB1, has resulted in additional funding to California localities for road funding such as repair or preservation of pavement. Also included would be pedestrian and bicycle projects. It is administered by the California Transportation Commission (CTC), and localities can participate via an annual application submission for these funds. The application has to include a list of projects that is approved by the governing body (our City Council).

**DISCUSSION:**

Council was presented the SB1 Proposed Project list on April 16, 2019; Council approved the list and concurred with submitting the list as part of the 2019 SB1 application. The list and other submittal documents were submitted to CTC well in advance of the May 1, 2019 deadline, and subsequently received an initial review by CTC staff.

Due to the nascent nature of the SB1 program, with several unknowns about fund amounts, including how project lists would be submitted, reviewed and approved, then applied to uses of SB1 funds, the submittals for the program’s initial two years were lengthy as they tried to cover all possibilities and timelines by showing multiple projects. As the program has matured, particularly with timelines, CTC staff has begun requesting the SB1 list submittal be reduced to focus on a single fiscal-year time frame. This year upon the initial review, CTC staff requested participating municipalities to reduce their lists to just projects intended to use SB1 funds in the upcoming fiscal year, FY 19-20. City staff has revised the SB1 submittal to show just the single project planned to use the anticipated SB1 revenue of \$125,000. This project is the construction of the ADA Curb Ramps at 18 locations along SR 116 that has an estimated cost of \$451,920.

It should be noted that SB1 funds are not intended to replace other funding sources that have been the norm for the City; SB1 money is supposed to be used for projects that otherwise might not get funded.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That the City Council Approve the Resolution Approving the Revised Proposed Projects List for SB1 projects funding

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEBASTOPOL SUBMITTING ITS  
RECOMMENDATION TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION OF A  
PROPOSED PROJECTS LIST FOR 2019-2020 FOR FUNDS TO BE ALLOCATED PER SB1

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol has a pavement preservation and management program for its Local Streets and Roads; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol has a Capital Improvements Program (CIP) that provides planned funding and timeframes for such projects; and

WHEREAS, the CIP is the basis for an application to the California Transportation Commission (CTC) for funds available under SB1 which contains a Proposed Project List; and

WHEREAS, the CIP for FY 2019-2020 was approved by the City Council via Resolution Number 6201 dated June 19, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sebastopol reviewed and indicated concurrence with the Proposed Project List at its meeting of April 16, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the initial Proposed Project List was submitted to CTC in advance of the May 1, 2019 submittal deadline; and

WHEREAS, the CTC conducted an initial review of the city of Sebastopol SB1 list, and requested the City to revise the SB1 list to only include projects slated for work and use of SB1 funds during FY 19-20; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol has duly revised the SB1 list per the CTC request and is presenting the revised list for Council review and approval.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Sebastopol approves and submits to the California Transportation Commission the Revised Local Streets and Roads List of Proposed Projects in order of priority for 2019-2020.
