<u>INTRODUCTION:</u> This item is to request that the Mayor and City Council Consider Appointments to the Five Openings on the Zero Waste Sub-Committee.

## DISCUSSION:

The Zero Waste Subcommittee shall consist of up to eleven (11) members as follows:

- 1. One City Council Member (Councilmember Carnacchi)
- 2. City Manager (Primary) Assistant City Manager (Alternate)
- 3. City Public Works Superintendent (Dante Del Prete)
- 4. City Waste Management Agency Representative (Henry Mikus)
- 5. City Local AB 939 Task force Representative (Sunny Galbraith)
- 6. Franchise Hauler Representative (Recology employee TBD)
- 7. Two Commercial Entities Representatives
- 8. Two Citizen Representatives
- 9. Student Representative

Citizen Representatives shall be from among residents of the City of Sebastopol and the Commercial Entities Representatives shall either be citizens of Sebastopol or the owner/employee of a business located within Sebastopol. The employee must be a resident of Sebastopol.

The Youth Representative shall be a student (9th - 12th grade) from Analy High School or Laguna High School and is required to furnish a signed permission/waiver from their parent or guardian.

Members shall not serve for more than four (4) years unless reappointed by the City Council.

It is anticipated that the first sub-committee meeting will be held within a month following appointment of the sub-committee members.

<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends that the Mayor and Council consider appointments to the five openings on the Zero Waste Sub-Committee with term ending dates of March 31, 2023.
