An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Sebastopol Amending the Sebastopol Municipal Code by Adding Chapter 8.06 (Tobacco Retailers) to Title 8 (Health and Safety) to Require the Licensure of Tobacco Retailers to Regulate the Sale and Distribution of Tobacco Products to Protect Minors

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Sebastopol has scheduled a Public Hearing for the first reading and introduction of an ordinance to Require the Licensure of Tobacco Retailers to Regulate the Sale and Distribution of Tobacco Products to Protect Minors. The ordinance limits the number and type of establishments that may sell tobacco products, and provides a local licensing system for tobacco retailers to ensure that retailers comply with tobacco control laws and business standards of the City to protect the health, safety, and welfare of our residents.

The City Council Meeting Scheduled for Tuesday, September 1, 2020, will be conducted virtually in accordance with Governor Newsom's State of Emergency declaration regarding the COVID-19 outbreak, Executive Order N-29-20, and the Guidance for Gatherings issued by the California Department of Public Health and Sonoma County Public Health Officer. City Councilmembers and staff will participate in the meeting virtually, while practicing social distancing, from individual remote locations.

Anyone interested may attend virtually by phone or computer and be heard at this meeting. Zoom Information will be available 72 hours prior to the City Council meeting. ZOOM allows for audio and visual participation.
