Dear Council Members,

Thank you for implementing parking options to prevent future Morris Street encampments in Sebastopol.

I strongly suggest that you include Citywide RV Permit Parking as another option for discussion.

This would allow homeowners and businesses the ability to legally park their RVs on the street. Sebastopol has a residential permit parking program in place. RV permit parking could be part of this program. From my casual observation, it seems that only 7-10 residents park their RVs on the street.

Citywide RV Permit Parking is:

1. Low cost - only \$10 per year for a permit;
2. Allows residents and business owners to legally park an RV on the Street;
3. Already established program;
4. Does not force timed parking in commercial areas which might not want timed parking;
5. Low impact - very few residents and/or businesses need to park RVs on the street, the few people that would need this program could be contacted by the Parking Tech with a letter similar to the one used for the Residential Parking Permit;

If for some reason you are unable to adopt Citywide RV Permit Parking. Then I would opt for implementing Option 1 (no residential street parking of oversized vehicles) and Option 2 (no parking of oversized vehicles in commercial and industrial areas between 6:00am and 10:00pm).

Thank you for addressing this extremely important issue for your constituents.
