Sorry I was watching the World Series and forgot to tune into the meeting. My main concern is whether or not the city is just increasing capacity or are they serious about not letting anyone park on Morris St. ever again. If they do allow folks to park there then they haven't really solved anything. They are just increasing the number of spaces that homeless folks can occupy.

Serious consideration should be made to doing what Cotati did in the 1970's when students were living in their vehicles on East Cotati Avenue in the 1970's. They created a trailer park* and then STOPPED people from parking their vehicles on E. Cotati Av. in front of the school. Sebastopol can do this in the old camp ground by creating an affordable camping area. It would require a real desire to help solve a problem as opposed to a "feel good" approach which has no measurable way to determine whether or not the effort was successful. As in was it worth the money, which buying the hotel in town clearly has been.
