MATERIALS & MEDIA

The selection panel is open to artwork in all media and materials. However, this artwork will be placed outside, so durability and safety are major factors when considering media and materials

The materials, design and palette must stand up to local weather and be amenable to ongoing maintenance.

Selected artist will be required to create a time-lapse video of the project as it develops.

ELIGIBILITY

The project is open California professional visual artists with experience implementing their ideas and work in the public realm. Artist or Professional Artist means a practitioner in the visual arts, generally recognized by critics and peers as a professional of serious intent and ability, income realized through the sole commission of artwork and frequent or consistent art

exhibitions. Artists are NOT eligible who are immediate family or business partners of members of the Public Art Committee or program (??) staff.

APPLYING FOR THIS PROJECT:

Applicants are asked to submit eight digital images of related previous work, a résumé, and a statement of interest no longer than 2,000 characters.

From these applications, the P.A.C. will choose up to three semifinalists to create proposals. Semifinalist artists will be provided with an honorarium of \$1000 to prepare and present their proposal in person. Semifinalists will be expected to pay for travel expenses from the honorarium.

Semifinalist Artists will present their proposals in person to a Public Forum Meeting and to a meeting of the P.A.C.

Following these presentations, the Finalist Selection will be made by the Sebastopol City Council with the advisement of the P.A.C.

The final selected artist or artist team for the commission will collaborate with the Public Arts Committee when finalizing their designs for installation.

Can a team apply?

Applicants may apply as a single artist or multi-person collaborative group. In the case of teams, please submit a single résumé for the whole team with 1-2 pages per team member.

MATERIALS TO BE SUBMITTED for PROJECT APPLICATION

Please read this section carefully. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered. The applicant's name must appear on all materials submitted.

◆ **Digital Images**—In order to be considered for this project, the applicant must electronically submit three to eight digital images of previously completed artwork.

Artists will be able to upload up to two video files.

ARTIST PROPOSAL STANDARD BUDGET:

Funds for the budget for this commission come from the City of Sebastopol's Art In-Lieu Fee Fund that is set aside for the commission of public artworks. The contract amount will be inclusive of all costs associated with the project including, but not limited to: the artist's design fee, other consultation fees such as structural engineering consultation, insurance, tools, materials, fabrication, transportation, installation, any building or site modification required, travel to and from the site, per diem expenses, maintenance, future replacement of parts if needed, project documentation, contingency to cover unexpected expenses, and any other costs.

- Quality of the artwork
- Experience of the artist.
- Durability, Maintenance & Safety of artwork design

GEOGRAPHIC SPECIFICATIONS

DURABILITY, MAINTENANCE & SAFETY

Please read this section carefully. The Durability, Maintenance & Safety of this project will be essential elements in the selection process.

All applicants are expected to consider the issues of long-term conservation and maintenance of public art, along with time and budget. These projects are located outside and in the public realm and may therefore be exposed to weather and physical stresses, as well as subjected to vandalism. Public art projects should be fabricated of highly durable, low-maintenance materials. The selected artist must apply an anti-graffiti coat to the finished product. The environmental effects of this project, during and after installation should be considered.

Semifinalists are encouraged to consult with a professional conservator prior to the submission of a final proposal. Artist proposals awarded contracts will be reviewed by the City of Denver's Public Art Committee and the Department of Construction and Engineering to ensure conformity with city standards of maintenance and durability, as well as ADA and safety standards. All finalists are expected to stay on budget and to complete work in an approved time frame.

INSTALLATION

The Public Arts Committee will review and inspect the design in person during installation periods once the artist/design is selected and approved.

Selected artist will be required to create a time-lapse video of the project as it develops.

The selected artist will have — days to complete the project.
